Last but not least, here is the text from Greg Brown that was put together as a template for you to email your legislators.

Thanks for your offer to communicate with legislators concerning funding for the arts. There is a new bill HB 4092 that has been authored by Rep. Rob Nosse and the Arts and Culture Caucus. When you contact legislators please ask them to sponsor and support the bill.

I don't know if you have written to legislators in the past, so I came up with some talking points:

Make the letter personal, but be sure to advocate for the arts in the whole State. Talk about growing up and what Art you were exposed to and delighted by. Tell how many years you have been attending the Opera, Symphony, PCS, Art Museum, etc. and with whom.

Let them know you live in Boring/Sandy and that (if you have) attended Sandy Mountain Festival, Sandy Actors Theater, Nuts and Bolts Theater at the Boring Grange and any other arts event you have gone to.

Remind them that arts organizations are economic drivers. They pay union wages, generate local, State and Federal tax revenue. They provide income to restaurants and bars -- many of which are small businesses. And they create revenue for hotels in the form of out of town guests. Discuss how the arts inspire people. The arts help people with mental illnesses and illness due to aging.
